

Performance during May, 2017

- (i) Commission advised issuance of sanction for prosecution in respect of **5** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (ii) Prosecution sanctions were issued by the Competent Authorities in respect of **5** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (iii) Commission advised initiation of major penalty proceedings against **178** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (iv) Commission advised imposition of major penalty against **14** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (v) On the advice of the Commission, the Competent Authorities imposed major penalties in respect of **166** officials of various Ministries/Departments/ Organizations.
- (vi) Intensive Examination of **03** work carried out by Chief Technical Examiner's Organization resulted in recoveries to the tune of **₹ 268.03 lakh** during **May, 2017**.
- (vii) Commission provided inputs in respect of **20** cases for vigilance clearance of officials for Board level appointments in CPSE's. In addition, references of **388** officials of All India Services and Central Services were considered for vigilance clearance in matters of empanelment, promotion etc. and inputs provided by the Commission.
- (viii) **17** officers were considered for appointment/empanelment as full time/part time CVOs in various organizations and recommendations were given by the Commission.
